

Resolution No. 2010-46

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ALBANY COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION
PLAN

WHEREAS, Albany County, Wyoming and the Municipalities therein, have the potential to experience disasters that can damage commercial, residential and public properties, displace citizens and businesses, close streets and bridges dividing the County and Municipalities, both physically and emotionally, and present general public health and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS the County and Municipalities have prepared a Hazard Mitigation Plan that outlines the options to reduce overall damage and impact from natural and technological hazards; and

WHEREAS the Albany County Hazard Mitigation Plan has been reviewed by the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), community residents, business owners, and federal, state and local agencies, and has been revised to reflect current federal, state and local requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Albany County Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of Albany County and all of its Municipalities.
2. The LEPC and Planning Committee are hereby tasked to be a permanent advisory body for this plan. The group's duties are as designated in the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
3. The County Commissioners are charged with supervising the implementation of the Plan's recommendations within the funding limitations as provided by the County budget. Individual Municipalities are also charged to implement the plans and projects as they can afford to complete them.
4. The LEPC, Planning Committee and the Emergency Management Coordinator shall monitor implementation of the plan and shall include in their minutes a progress report to the County Commissioners in accordance with the following format:
 - a. A review of the original plan (yearly), no later than the 30th day of September.
 - b. A review of any disasters or emergencies that occurred during the previous calendar year.
 - c. A review of the actions taken, including what was accomplished during the previous year.
 - d. A discussion of any implementation problems.
 - e. Recommendations for new projects or revised action items.

5. All levels of local government shall incorporate the requirements of the Mitigation Plan into other planning mechanisms such as comprehensive or capital improvement plans, as appropriate.
6. The Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) is designated as the Only Person Responsible (OPR) for the maintenance of their official plan; however each agency addressed in the plan is responsible for the applicability of tasks listed. Changes or inputs to this plan should be addressed to the EMC. This plan has been coordinated through all responsible agencies, Wyoming Office of Homeland Security, (WOHS) and FEMA.
