

RESOLUTION 2009- 64

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING WITH THE WYOMING BUSINESS COUNCIL (WBC) FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) – COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AWARD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000 TO INSTALL A SECONDARY WATERLINE TO SERVE AREAS SOUTH OF LARAMIE.

Whereas, the Wyoming Business Council is authorized to make grants to cities and counties for a variety of purposes, including and water supply and storage;

Whereas, the City of Laramie, Wyoming (City) is seeking a CDBG, Community Development award through WBC in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 to extend a secondary waterline to provide adequate water service and fire protection to areas south of Laramie in the vicinity of the Albany County Fair Grounds;

Whereas, City Council conducted a public hearing on July 21, 2009 and gave full consideration to all comments received at the hearing;

Whereas, no City funding will be used as the match for this grant or for any portion of this project; and

Whereas, the City of Laramie will seek funding from the Wyoming Water Development Commission and the United States Department of Agriculture to provide additional funds to this project;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the foregoing recitals are incorporated in and made a part of this resolution by this reference.

Section 2. That, City Council supports the filing of an application by City with WBC for a CDBG, Community Development award in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 to extend a secondary waterline to areas south of Laramie.
