

RESOLUTION 2013-71

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING DOG FRIENDLY AREAS AND TIMES WITHIN
CITY PARKS WHEN A DOG IS NOT AT LARGE**

WHEREAS, on October 18th, 2011 Original Ordinance 1832 governing animals within the City of Laramie was passed by City Council, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie and the University of Wyoming, Joint Management Team agree that a proposed fenced area located on the north side of the Sandy Aragon Softball Complex will provide the community with a fenced dog friendly off-leash area on the east side of Laramie, and;

WHEREAS, the citizens of Laramie have requested city staff to provide fenced dog friendly off-leash areas throughout our community, and;

WHEREAS, the Parks, Tree and Recreation Advisory Board recommended the City Council designate the proposed fence area on north side of Sandy Aragon Softball Complex from dawn to dusk when a dog is not at large.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the foregoing recitals are incorporated in and made part of this resolution by reference.

SECTION 2: That the City Council does hereby designate the Sandy Aragon Softball Complex fenced area from dawn to dusk where a dog is not considered to be at large as detailed in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
