

September of 2007 saw the beginning of the Main Lift rehabilitation project begin for the City of Laramie. The main Lift Pump Stations conveys 80% of the wastewater to the wastewater treatment plant (WWTP). The beginning of the project involves putting the construction trailers on site and demolition of the old concrete walkways and pads. Replacement of pumps, a new screening device and electrical upgrades are all part of this 2.3 million dollar project. The monies for this project are coming from the state in the form of a 2.5% loan from the Wyoming State Loan and Investment Board in the amount of \$827,574.00. A grant of \$2,482,717.00 is from the State Revolving Fund. Any extra money will possibly go into replacing 50 year old force mains.
